- Level of English required for admission to the specialization course: TOEIC 780 / IELTS 6 / IBT 85 (candidates with at least 1 year of studies or professional experience in an English-speaking country are exempted). For admission to the preparation course, the level of English is recommended but not mandatory. It will have to be validated to enter the 2nd year.
